

This story is about God making the heavens and the earth.



STORY 2: God makes the animals and man


This story is about the first man.

Colour the picture. Join the dots below to find out what God thought about His creation.






STORY 3: The first man and woman

STORY 4: God's world is spoiled


This story is about sin coming into the world.
