When God made the world there was so much to make - how did He do it?

The first verse of the Bible tells us that:

***“In the beginning God created the heavens and the earth.”* Genesis 1: 1**

This means that He made them out of nothing. Before God made the world there was just darkness. God is so great that when He made the world all He had to do was speak.

Day 1

On the first day, God said, “Let there be light.” Immediately there was light. God called the light “day” and the darkness “night.” Instead of darkness all the time there was day followed by night.



Day 2

On the second day, God spoke again and created the sky and the air which are all around the earth. Night came again and the second day ended.

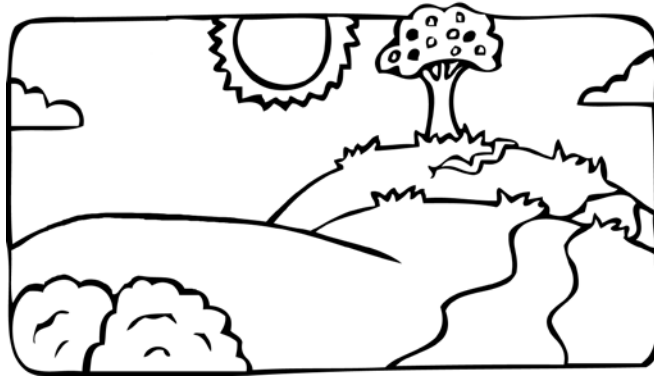

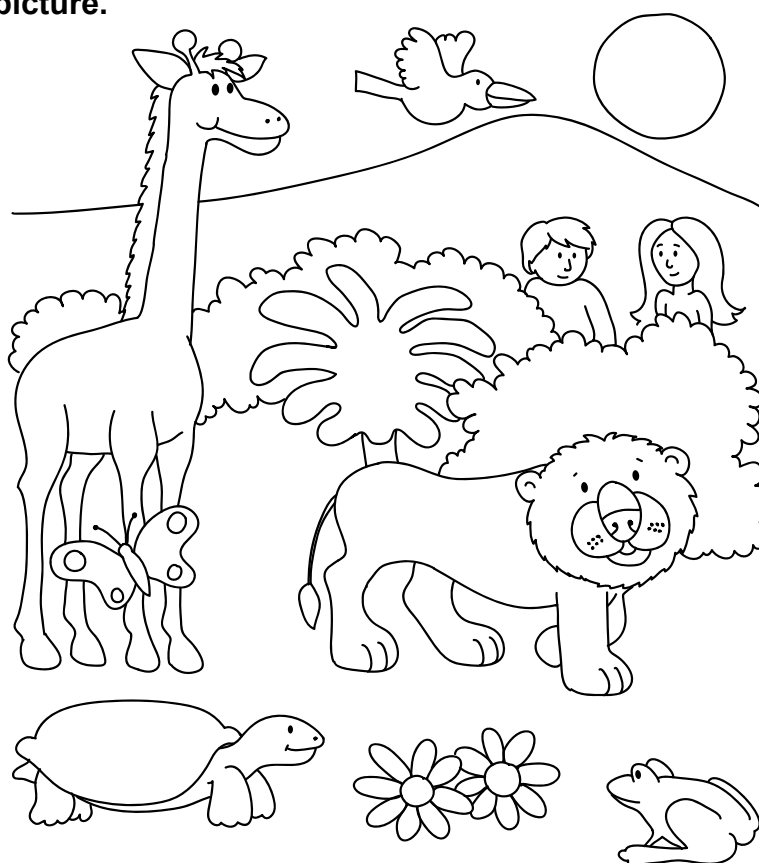

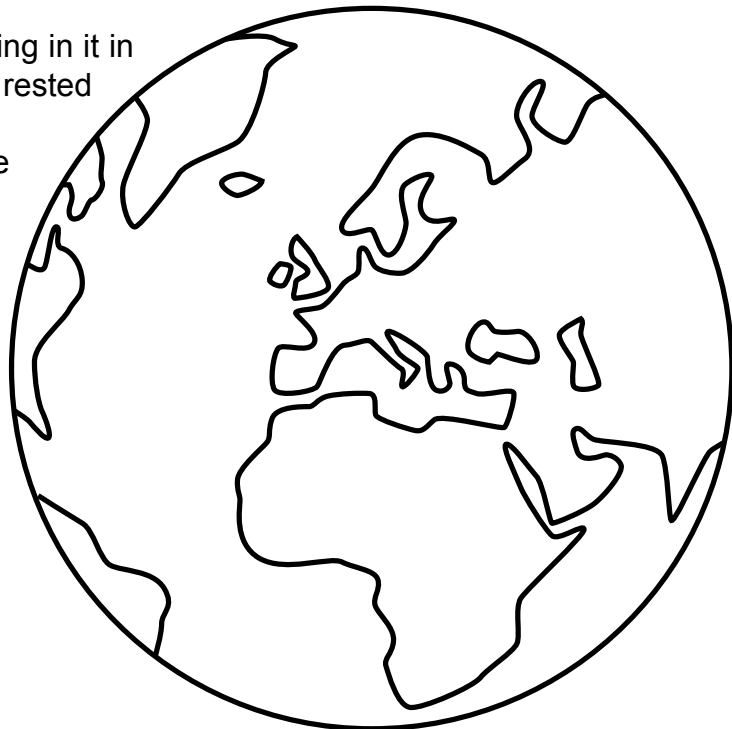
Day 7

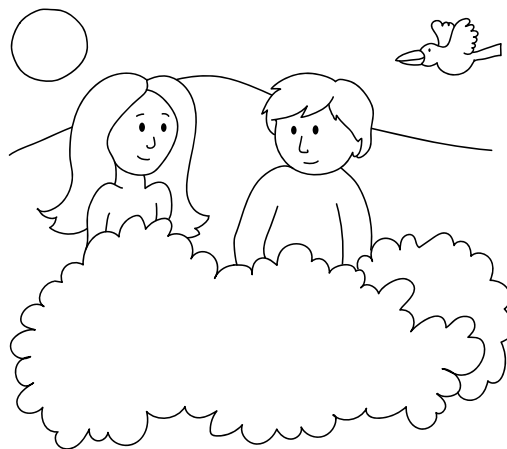

Adam was no longer alone. He now had someone who would be his wife and companion as he looked after the garden in which God had put him.

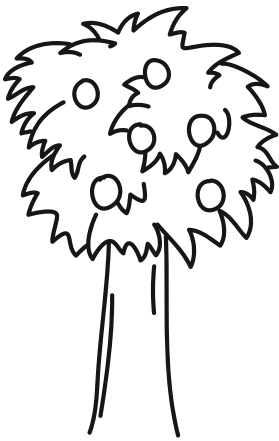

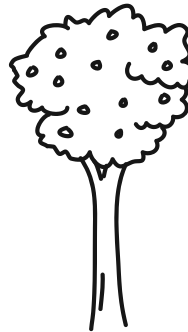

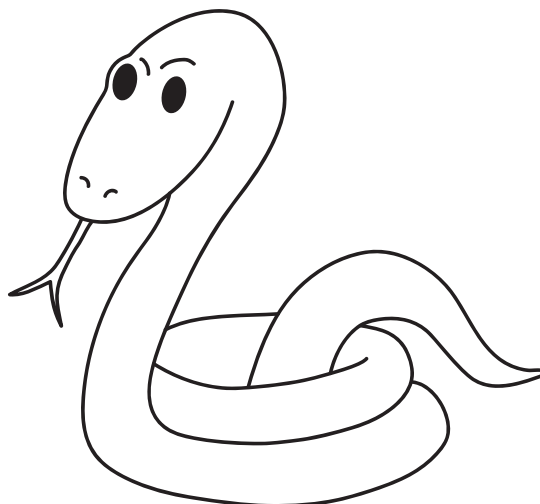
Eve listened to God's enemy. She then disobeyed God and took some of the fruit. She gave some to Adam and they both ate it.
